

The JULIAN SAMORA ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS



(Graduate/Undergraduate) For 2017-2018

The Julian Samora Research Institute (JSRI) is proud to provide an opportunity to continuing MSU students to apply for the Julian Samora Endowed Scholarships for academic year 2017-2018. The scholarships, named in honor of Dr. Julian Samora, support two students (one **Graduate** and one **Undergraduate**) engaged in scholarly activities focused on Latino/as in Midwestern communities. Applications will be reviewed and recommended by the JSRI Scholarship Committee. Awardees in each category will be announced March 2017.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be current MSU students and **must be attending MSU fall 2017 and spring 2018**. They must demonstrate excellent academic standing, and provide evidence of interest in research on Chicano/Latino communities. For the 2017-18 academic year, a \$1,000 credit will appear both fall and spring semesters.

INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants must submit the following materials by Friday, February 10, 2017.

- 1. Cover letter with personal statement describing accomplishments, research/educational interests, and student goals.
- 2. Latest official transcript from MSU.
- 3. Resume which includes current local address and phone number.
- 4. One letter of recommendation from a professor or academic advisor.

The Scholarship Committee will nominate two applicant finalists: one an undergraduate student, and a graduate student.

DEADLINE

Submissions must be received at JSRI by 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, February 10, 2017**.
