The Diversity Assessment and Engagement Program (DAEP) offers certification in diversity leadership to mid- and senior-level leaders in public, private, and non-profit organizations interested in building culturally competent, diverse organizations. The ten-month program consists of 3-hour, face-to-face, monthly modules in which participants gain knowledge and skills in the following areas:

- Self-awareness of personal values, perspectives and behaviors that shape interactions with persons from cultures other than one's own;
- Critical understanding of the structural features of organizations and the social order that maintain and reproduce differential opportunities across members of different social groups;
- Approaches for promoting diversity issues within organizations and the challenges diversity leaders face in advancing multicultural competence within their own organizations;
- Personal efficacy in leading and developing multicultural workplaces and providing services in diverse environments; and
- Sustainable practices for engaging diverse populations.
