“Unequal Higher Education and the Birth of Vulnerable Public”

The higher education system in the United States is steeply stratified. But in recent decades inequality among higher education has grown. In a forthcoming book titled *Unequal Higher Education* (Rutgers University Press) Barrett Taylor (University of North Texas) and Brendan Cantwell identify financial and social mechanisms that drive institutional inequality. In this presentation Brendan Cantwell will focus on one notable finding – the recent creation of public institutions whose extreme tuition dependence makes them vulnerable to closure – and discusses the implications for student opportunity and social equity.
